**Rules and Regulations**

- A new Beaver Buggy shall be built each year; a Beaver Buggy from a previous year will not be registered.
- The Beaver Buggy shall be free-wheeling and may be propelled only by the force of gravity.
- Wheel bearings, washers and bushings are prohibited.
- The Beaver Buggy may not ride on springs.
- Wheels shall not be shaped or profiled, but may be sanded to remove mould flashing or burrs.
- Details and attachments may be added providing they are securely fastened.
- Lubrication may be applied to the axles only before registration. Dry graphite is the preferred lubricant. Excess lubricant on the Beaver Buggy which may affect other Beaver Buggies or the track shall be removed.
- The final paint or finish of the Beaver Buggy shall be dry to the touch upon registration. Beaver Buggies with wet paint or finish shall not be eligible for registration as this will affect the track and, by extension, other Beaver Buggies.
- All Beaver Buggies shall be subject to inspection by an official inspector or inspectors to determine eligibility.
- Beaver Buggies shall be kept at the marshalling area (the "Pits") once they have been registered.
- Beaver Buggies may not be modified in any way after they have been registered.
- After registration, a Beaver Buggy shall not be handled by any person except the Beaver to whom it belongs or Rally staff.
